I am aware that there has been some concern and discussion around the behaviour of a couple of students, and the impact this has on children and their learning. There have been so many wonderful and positive things happening at school, and it seems this has unfortunately been overshadowed by a 1-2 of incidents during lunchtime.

We have very high expectations for student behaviour, in and out of the classroom. When children don't meet our expectations, or are behaving in an unsettled or unsafe way, we respond quickly to ensure the safety and wellbeing of students is maintained. We have a very clear process and staged response for managing behaviour, and it is not always published what consequences or follow up is put in place. Every child and family has a right to privacy, and every child has a reason for responding the way they do.

Our goal is to work with students and families to help students learn to manage negative and difficult emotions in a constructive way, as we do at home as families. As a school we work with families to understand the context of a behaviour, to minimise and eliminate any issues. However, despite everyone's best efforts and intentions, children are learning, and can have a bad day and behave in an unacceptable way. When this occurs, we use our staged response to manage behaviour. This includes consequences for behaviour such as walking with the Yard Duty teacher, Zone, exclusion from a particular area in the yard, withdrawal from the yard, and internal and external suspensions. Ongoing issues are also managed through family meetings, Behaviour Support Plans and Safety Plans.

Thank you to those parents who have contacted me to discuss their concerns, and I encourage you to contact your child's teacher, our Assistant Principal Mrs Harris, or myself, to discuss any concerns or questions.
