# **Principal's Report**

We did it – a full year with no Lockdowns! At first it was a full term with no remote learning, then a semester, and here we are. It has certainly been tiring and challenging, especially for our younger students who hadn't yet experienced a full year at school.

It has been wonderful to host so many whole school events to bring our community together to celebrate and enjoy time together throughout the year. I have really enjoyed the Book Fair and Grandparent's Day, as well as the Mother & Father's Day Stalls, Letterland Day, the Book Week Parade, and celebrating our first Colour Run which is sure to become an annual fixture. Our first Fun Fair since 2018 was a wonderful success, raising over \$30,000 towards shade sails and improvements in the yard for students.

We have also celebrated some great sporting successes including our first involvement in HoopTime, and District and Division representation in AFL, Soccer, Netball, Cricket, Tennis, Swimming and Athletics. Our House Athletics Carnival was a fun time together where all students tried to further, higher and faster!

We were able to celebrate the completion of this stage of building works and officially open all of our school buildings. Our historic building now refurbished and houses the Library, STEM Room and Wellbeing Room with a gorgeous Linkway to connect to the Junior School. We have a new Senior building and Kitchen, new toilets for students, a new Gr 3/4 portable and two netball courts. In the yard we now have the Nature Play, Kitchen Garden and Assembly courtyard and bleachers. Our Official Opening with our Local Member and Education Minister James Merlino was held on August 19th. Our Community Open Day was held on Saturday August 20<sup>th</sup>, well supported by so many MPS alumni see our new spaces.

All of these wonderful successes and great memories wouldn't have been possible without the wonderful staff at Monbulk Primary School, and the support of our school families and the community. MPS is a very special school, which I am proud to lead. Thank you for you support and I wish every family a safe and happy holiday period.

If you are in need of assistance with issues such as financial or family violence, please speak to someone at the Pantry or the Op Shop. We are there to help.


