Principal's Report

Phonics Programs in Victorian Schools

Today the Victorian Government announced that from next year, all Government schools will be teaching 25mins of phonics each day, from Prep-Gr 2. Phonics is teaching children the sounds that letter make by themselves, and when blended. For example, the letter 'C' makes a 'kh' sound. 'ch' make the sound 'ch as in cheese', or 'k' as in school. Children have readers called 'Decodables' to help them understand the letters and sounds, and how to read unfamiliar words. Phonics is a research-based approach to teaching reading.

At Monbulk PS we already directly teach phonics in our Prep-2 program for around 30 mins a day. Phonics are also woven into our other learning, and into our Readers and Book Boxes. Reading to your children every night, and listening to them read is a very powerful and effective way to help develop their reading skills.

Young Leaders for Equality and Respect

Congratulations to a group of Gr 5 students who participated in the Respectful Relationships project 'Young leaders for equality and respect'.

Students from school across the hills met at Belgrave Sth Primary School over 3 workshops. Students learned about gender equality and inclusion, harmful gender-based stereotypes, and looked at their own schools to understand our next steps.

Ella O, Michael, Hudson, Olivia, Faye, Violet, and Sofia completed a project about where girls and boys feel most comfortable to play in the yard. Each child coloured in on a map where they play the most. The young leaders then developed actions to help address this, so that every student feels comfortable to play in every part of the yard. They presented their finding on Tues 11th June to local Principals and Regional Department of Education Leaders. We are very proud of these young leaders for standing up and working to make our school a more inclusive space, and stand up for equality and inclusion.

A GUIDE FOR PARENTS

SOME SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

The following are some activities that you can do with your children. Some are general and some relate to specific aspects of the mathematics curriculum.

LEARNING TO COUNT

Learning to count is important. Counting 1,2,3,4..... is the main way, but also counting using patterns:

2, 4, 6, 8..... 100, 99, 98, 97..... 0.5, 1, 1.5, 2..... 5, 10, 15, 20.... 100, 90, 80, 70.... a, b, c, d.....

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday..... January, February, March.....

Nursery rhymes help with forwards and backwards counting. "Five little ducks", "1,2,3,4,5, once I caught a fish alive", "10 green bottles", are just a few examples of the nursery rhymes you can say together.

When walking around the block, predict the next house number and then check.

NUMBER FACTS

Knowing number facts is very useful for the future mathematical studies of your children. You can help by taking an interest and by giving them practice. There are a number of important elements about learning tables and number facts.

First is that all the number facts come in families. If the children know, for example, that 5+2=7 is the same as 2+5=7 and relates to 7-2=5 and 7-5=2, then they know a lot of facts. The same is true for multiplication. If they know that $5\times4=20$, they also know $4\times5=20$, $20\div5=4$ and $20\div4=5$.

Next they need to learn general principles such as adding 1, adding 2, doubles, near doubles (5+6 is the same as 5+5+1), adding 10, adding 9 (by adding 10 and taking away 1). For multiplication they can learn about doubling (x by 2), multiplication by 10, 5, 4, 3, first, then the rest.


