Please be mindful that the Hub car park is shared with the Living and Learning Centre and Monbulk Pre-School. The 9am drop off and particularly the 3.30pm pick up are very busy times. We have worked with Yarra Ranges Council and School Council to help ensure the flow of traffic is always main-

tained to allow other patrons to exit the carpark. At pick up and drop off times all vehicles are required to exit the car park by <u>turning left</u> being mindful and courteous to our School Crossing Staff. Crossings are attended between 8am and 9am in the morning and 3pm to 4pm in the afternoon. 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A GUIDE FOR PARENTS

SOME SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

The following are some activities that you can do with your children. Some are general and some relate to specific aspects of the mathematics curriculum.

NUMBER GAMES, BOARD GAMES & OTHER GAMES

There are a range of games which are published in books and which are suitable as family games and which practice mathematics skills. One card game commonly available now is called *Numero* which can be purchased in games' shops and newsagents. These provide practice with mental arithmetic. There are also more traditional games such as *Gin Rummy*, Snakes and Ladders, and Ludo which provide some experience at addition and useful practice for children.

When playing games for which there is a degree of logical thinking implied, talk with the children about better moves, or plays which lead to winning. Think together about ways which help not to lose rather than to win. Verbalising strategies are important for logical thinking.

Some other games that can be played easily include:

Car number plates

When your car pulls up behind the car in front, you might have a competition to see how many different answers children can make using the numbers from the car number plate. For example, if the number plate is 152 the children might say:

 $1 \times 5 + 2$ is 7, or 1 + 5 + 2 is 8, or $(1 + 5) \times 2$ is 12 and so on. Another idea is to add the digits like this: 157 becomes 1 + 5 + 7 which is 13, then 1 + 3 = 4 and to see which number plate will give a special target number.

Guess the pattern

One player thinks of a rule (such as double and add 1). Other players can suggest a number (such as 5) and the first player tells them the number which results from the pattern (11). The players can keep testing numbers until they can tell what the rule is.

Guess my number

One player thinks of a number, say between 1 and 100, the other player can ask questions only using the words "more or less". For example, a player might ask "Is the number more than 52?" The first player must answer either yes or no.






Sierra Voices Primary Choir: Location: Monbulk Primary School

Notification of Works Demolition works at Monbulk Soccer Club Pavilion and attached Toilets

As part of Yarra Ranges Council, Major Projects program, demolition is about to commence on the existing Monbulk Soccer Club Pavilion Building and attached toilets at 9 Moores Road Monbulk.

The works are scheduled to commence in mid July 2024 and expected to be completed within 3 months, subject to favourable conditions.

Please be aware that while we will make every attempt to keep disruptions to a minimum, due to the nature and extent of the works there are likely to be some disruptions with noise, access and traffic flow in the surrounding streets during normal construction working hours from 7.00 am to 5.30 pm on weekdays.

As there will be contractors and plant operating in close proximity to traffic and users, for the safety of all we request that you

- Keep your speed under 20km/h within and around works site
- Be prepared to stop as you approach the works (by car or by foot)
 Follow directions given by construction personnel and / or traffic controllers; and
 Do not enter construction zones that are signed as such

As a matter of added safety, children should be advised to keep away from the works throughout their duration.
