Ramp Remediation works

A recent audit of Victorian school found many ramp were not compliant, including at Monbulk Primary School.

The Department is funding the remediation of ramps to ensure they are safe and complient. The ramps being demolished and rebuilt are the long concrete ramp near the Shade Sails, the wooden ramp alongside the heritage building, and some minor works to the ramp leading from the senior building to the Shade Sails. Works are planned to be completed by early April.

District swimming Report

Pippa and Emmet both earned impressive 3rd place finishes in their age group for backstroke, with Pippa clocking in at 39.22 seconds and Emmet at 41.19 seconds. They also each triumphed in their freestyle heats, showcasing their versatility and skill. Ella shone brightly, securing 3rd place in both the freestyle and butterfly heats—an outstanding performance across the board. Jack's presence in the water was nothing short of powerful and graceful, with onlookers joking he must be part fish! He dominated his races, defeating his longtime rival Zephyr from The Patch in both freestyle (25.88) and butterfly (32.03). Jack will be advancing to the next stage in both events. The rest of our team—Em, Myla, Sadie, and Mila—gave their all, representing Monbulk with determination, supporting one another, and demonstrating excellent sportsmanship throughout the competition.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- · \$154 for primary school students
- · \$256 for secondary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the website below.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments: your child has started or changed schools this year.
- changed family circumstances: such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

Check with the school office if you are unsure
