### CSEF Camps Sports & Excursions Fund—2025 Applications close 4th July 2025

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A \$154 allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the website below.

If you applied for CSEF last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

### Apply now to enrol your child in Foundation (Prep) for 2026

The Department of Education has a statewide timeline for enrolling in Foundation (Prep) for the 2026 school year.

If you have a child starting primary school in 2026, it's time to enrol. Make sure to submit your enrolment application by **Friday 25 July 2025.** 

If you are enrolling the sibling of a student at our school for Foundation in 2026, and both children will be attending our school at the same time, your child is prioritised for a place at our school as per the department's Placement Policy.

It is important to follow the statewide timeline to enrol your child in Foundation. Enrolling your child in line with the timelines allows us to plan our classrooms, staffing and transition activities and ensures your child has the best start to school.
