Every Day Counts – Missing school is missing out!

This term we are launching an attendance initiative at MPS called *'Every Day Counts'*.

Our attendance motto is 'Every Day Counts - Missing School is Missing Out!'.

Regular school attendance is crucial for students to reach their full potential. Every day of learning counts.

Missing school, even occasionally, can lead to learning gaps and make it harder for children to stay connected socially and emotionally. Therefore, we're working to improve our attendance as a whole school.

What does 'Every Day Counts' involve?

- Celebrating outstanding or improved attendance at Assemblies with an Attendance Award
- Late Passes replaced with Welcome Passes
- Recording Attendance Rates on Semester Reports
- Publicity, including posters and fridge magnets
- Support for families and students at risk of chronic absence, including letters home to alert families regarding attendance
- Streamlined support and referral to services for students either at risk of or experiencing chronic absence, school reluctance or school refusal
- Attendance as a regular agenda items for Student Support Group meetings and Parent Teacher Interviews.

Department Guidelines regarding target attendance rates are below:

Regular attenders: miss less than 10 days (2 weeks) a year

Risk of chronic absence: miss between 10-19 days (2-4 weeks) a year

Chronically absent: miss 20+ days (1 month) a year.

Students who are chronically absent miss around a year of school by Year 10.

You can check your child's attendance through the Compass portal.

We understand that attendance can be a tricky and challenging issue for students and families, and we're here to work together with you to support your child.

If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me or our Wellbeing Team at the school.



Smile Squad is coming to Monbulk Primary School

Dear families,

The Smile Squad team from EACH are coming to our school from Monday 11th August 2025.

Smile Squad is the Victorian Government free school dental program.

This means all students can get a free dental check-up, preventive services, and treatment at school.

How to access free dental care

We need your consent before we can provide services. Consent is usually provided by a parent or guardian.

Please complete and submit the consent form, this will be sent directly to EACH.

Paper copies of the consent form are available. Please contact the school office if you would like to request one.

The electronic consent form can be translated into more than 100 languages, and the paper form is available in 13 languages.

Smile Squad dental packs

All children deserve a healthy smile, and the Smile Squad free school dental program is working hard to help make sure this happens. Your child(ren) will soon receive a free dental pack to bring home. The dental pack contains a toothbrush, full sized toothpaste, and an oral health brochure. Please take the time to read the brochure. It's full of helpful hints and tips to help your whole family eat well, drink well and clean well – for life.

Smile Squad provides standard strength fluoride toothpaste that is generally used by ages six and over, unless recommended by a dental or trained health professional.

If your child is under six, please talk to a dental or trained health professional to find out if your child might benefit from using this toothpaste. You can also choose to put the toothpaste away until they turn six or give it to someone else in your family to use.

Do I need to attend my child's appointment?

No, you do not need to attend your child's appointment. You can attend if you would like to, and you can take your child to the community dental clinic if you prefer.


