### **Our New Transition Expectation**

This week we are introducing our 'Outside to Inside' transition routine.

We've noticed that different year levels have different routine from bringing children in from yard after playtime, or at the start of the day.

This can be confusing for student and parents. As a school we have decided to have a single process for ever time we go from Outside to Inside, regardless of whether we have our classroom teacher or specialist teacher.

The single process reduces the cognitive load for students as there's only one routine to remember. It also supports school staff and parents in helping student in to the routine.

Students have been learning the Outside to Inside transition expectation this week. Please see the flow chart below.

Accommodations are made for students who require a different approach, and our goal is for all students to be able to participate in the expected routine.

Sometimes, students can perceive equity as unfair (unequal). For example, a student may have more time with a teacher, tutoring, different work or different consequences.


This is because we are working together to give each student what they need to achieve, using equity to support inclusion.

These parents will receive an email containing a link and instruction on how to access the survey.

The online survey will be available in English and 10 other languages including Arabic, Greek, Hakha Chin, Hindi, Japanese, Punjabi, Simplified Chinese, Somali, Turkish, and Vietnamese. Resources are also available in additional languages to assist parents / caregivers / guardians who speak a language other than English at home. ### Smile Squad is coming to Monbulk Primary School

Dear families,

The Smile Squad team from EACH are coming to our school from Monday 11<sup>th</sup> August 2025 until 22nd August.

Smile Squad is the Victorian Government free school dental program.

This means all students can get a free dental check-up, preventive services, and treatment at school.

### How to access free dental care

We need your consent before we can provide services. Consent is usually provided by a parent or guardian.

Please complete and submit the consent form, this will be sent directly to EACH.

Paper copies of the consent form are available. Please contact the school office if you would like to request one.

The electronic consent form can be translated into more than 100 languages, and the paper form is available in 13 languages.

### **Smile Squad dental packs**

All children deserve a healthy smile, and the Smile Squad free school dental program is working hard to help make sure this happens. Your child(ren) will soon receive a free dental pack to bring home. The dental pack contains a toothbrush, full sized toothpaste, and an oral health brochure. Please take the time to read the brochure. It's full of helpful hints and tips to help your whole family eat well, drink well and clean well – for life.

Smile Squad provides standard strength fluoride toothpaste that is generally used by ages six and over, unless recommended by a dental or trained health professional.

If your child is under six, please talk to a dental or trained health professional to find out if your child might benefit from using this toothpaste. You can also choose to put the toothpaste away until they turn six or give it to someone else in your family to use.

### Do I need to attend my child's appointment?

No, you do not need to attend your child's appointment. You can attend if you would like to, and you can take your child to the community dental clinic if you prefer.

### **Car Park Courtesy and Keeping Our Kids Safe**

Please be mindful that the Hub car park is shared with the Living and Learning Centre and Monbulk Pre-School. The 9am drop off and particularly the 3.30pm pick up are very busy times. We have worked with Yarra Ranges Council and School Council to help ensure the flow of traffic is always maintained to allow other patrons to exit the carpark. At pick up and drop off times all vehicles are required to exit the car park by <a href="turning left">turning left</a> being mindful and courteous to our School Crossing Staff. Crossings are attended between 8am and 9am in the morning and 3pm to 4pm in the afternoon.

The area just before the crossing and kiss and drop zone is no standing—DO NOT stop here as it blocks the view and moving vehicles cannot see if children are about to enter the crossing. See Picture to the below.

Keep the traffic moving in the car park before 3.30pm. Other options are to use the round abouts at Moxhams Road and Emerald-Monbulk Rd to keep traffic moving, or if time allows consider parking elsewhere close by in Monbulk, or around the Oval.

If we all follow these steps we will **keep our children**, car park and roads safe.




