 - Immunisation Certificate.





2027 Transition

In the 1st week of 2027 Prep students will meet one on one with their teacher for 1hr to determine their entry level skills for literacy and numeracy.

In the 2nd week of 2027 students attend school from 8.50am until 1pm.

Week 3 and beyond the Preps stay at school full time, 8.50am to 3.10pm

Our 'Step into Prep' program supports the transition into primary school by providing children with a relaxed, safe and caring experience that allows them to feel comfortable within our school environment. Each week, children experience a different aspect of learning and school life through a range of activities ensuring our future students become familiar with the school, classrooms and each other.

All Prep students have a Grade 6 Buddy. The role of our buddies is to guide Prep students, ensuring they feel safe and secure in the school environment. They will continue to engage in experiences together and will develop a strong relationship with their buddy throughout the year.

We build confident learners through teaching students at their point of need. We deliver a phonics program for reading, love of writing, and explore maths through challenging and fun games, puzzles and explicit instruction.
